PLAINS OF WATERLOO, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow sewer repair works to be carried out part of a programme to replace Thanet's ageing sewers, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Plains of Waterloo, Ramsgate.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 6 January 2020, with estimated completion by 27 February.

Plains of Waterloo will be closed in phases between the junctions with Bellevue Road and King Street

These works are subject to weather and other factors which make it difficult to provide accurate timing of the phases; the specific dates of the phases will be signposted on site and notified to local residents, businesses.

The alternative routes for all through traffic are

- B2054 Wellington Crescent, Victoria Parade, Victoria Road and King Street and vice versa
- *Eastbound only* via King Street, Brunswick Street, Hardres Street, A255 Boundary Road, B2054 Victoria Road and Bellevue Road

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

Plains of Waterloo will be re-opened briefly when there is a closure of nearby King Street.
