PLAINS OF WATERLOO, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Plains of Waterloo and Balmoral Place, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 7 September 2020, with estimated completion by 11 September 2020.

PLAINS OF WATERLOO will be closed between the junctions with Waterloo Place and Balmoral Place, to the extent indicated on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via B2054 Wellington Crescent, Victoria Parade, Victoria Road and Bellevue Road.

BALMORAL PLACE will be closed between the junctions with Plains of Waterloo and Irchester Street.

Access to the *cul-de-sac* section of Balmoral Place continues via Irchester Street

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.
