**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & NO RIGHT TURN)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow mains repairs works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Princes Road, Ramsgate. The right turn out of A254 Margate Road onto Princes Road will be prohibited.

A closure is planned from 15th June 2022, with estimated completion by 21st June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT11857378-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Princes Road will be closed at its junction with A254 Margate Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while mains repairs works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A254 Margate Road, Station Approach Road, Princes Road, and vice versa.
