TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Queen Bertha Road, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 17th August 2020 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Queen Bertha Road and St Lawrence Avenue.

The alternative route is via Southwood Road, Napleton Road and St Mildreds Road.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
