**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

**Kent County Council gives notice that Queen Bertha Road, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 25 March 2020 for up to 2 days.**

**The road will be closed between the junctions of St Mildred's Road and Southwood Road.**

**The alternative route is via Southwood Road, Napleton Road, St Mildred's Road and vice versa.**

**Kent County Council gives notice that waiting will be prohibited at all times on Queen Bertha Road, Ramsgate, from 25 March 2020 for up to 2 days.**

**This applies to both sides of Queen Bertha Road, Ramsgate, between the junctions of St Mildred's Road and Southwood Road.**

**The Notice has the effect of over-riding any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the sections of road defined above.**

**The closure is necessary to enable Kent County Council to carry out urgent carriageway repairs.**

**This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.**
