TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Queen Street, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 25th November 2022 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Elms Avenue and Cliff Street.

The alternative route is via West Cliff Road, B2054 Grange Road, B2054 St Augustine's Road, Paragon, Royal Parade and Leopold Street.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 20:00 hrs and 05:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
