**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Queens Road and Brockenhurst Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours from 23rd May 2022, with estimated completion by 25th May 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SECHA000185403ONSA1-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Queens Road and Brockenhurst Road, Ramsgate, will be closed between number 34 Queens Road and number 11 Brockenhurst Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Brockenhurst Road, Victoria Parade, Lyndhurst Road, Queens Road, and vice versa.
