**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rear Access To Homefleet House, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours from 2nd May 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd May 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SEPOL0000175693ONSA-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Rear Access To Homefleet House will be closed between the rear of number 16 and number 20 Shaftbury Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

No diversion route available, but access will be maintained when it is safe to do so.
