



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
RODNEY STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to install a new manhole, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rodney Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Wednesday 13 January 2021, with estimated completion by 20 January 2021.

Rodney Street, Ramsgate will be closed in the general vicinity of number 22, near the T-junction, to the actual extent indicated on site.

Local access to the remainder of Rodney Street continues from either direction, with access to the *cul-de-sac* section via West Cliff Road

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Addington Street and West Cliff Road

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
