RODNEY STREET, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2021

To allow works to be carried to install new gas, water and drainage connections for a forthcoming development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rodney Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 15 March 2021, with estimated completion by 19 March 2019.

Rodney Street will be closed westwards from and including the T-junction, with no access to the *cul-de-sac* section.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Addington Street and West Cliff Road

Local access to the remainder of Rodney Street is extremely limited.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Future Homes (Kent) Ltd Permit PAA yet to be confirmed], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
