(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rodney Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 28th June 2023, with estimated completion by 6th July 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WDRR767X-04 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Rodney Street will be closed between the junctions of West Cliff Road and Addington Street. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while To allow utility works to be carried out works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Rodney Street, West Cliff Road, Hertford Street, Hertford Place, Addington Street and vice versa.
