**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY ORDER)  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2023**

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Royal Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 8th March 2023, with estimated completion by 14th March 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT12331223-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Royal Road will be closed between the junctions of West Cliff Road and B2054 St Augustines Road. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site. The one-way Order on Royal Road will be temporarily suspended, between the junctions of West Cliff Road and B2054 St Augustines Road, to allow for diverted traffic.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Royal Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Grange Road, London Road, West Cliff Road and vice versa.
