ROYAL ROAD, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Royal Road, Ramsgate.

Daytime closures are planned from Thursday 24 June 2021 for up to 5 days, between 08:00 hours and approximately 18:00 hours each day.

Royal Road will be closed between the junctions with Warwick Mews and Priory Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via West Cliff Road, B2054 Grange Road, St Augustine's Road, Paragon, Addington Street and Townley Street.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Royal Road will be suspended between the junctions with West Cliff Road and Townley Street to allow essential access / exit from either direction up to where the road is closed.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
