



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
SOUTH EASTERN ROAD, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on South Eastern Road, Ramsgate.

Phased closures are now planned from Monday 7 September 2020, with completion currently estimated by 18 December 2020.

These works have now been re-scheduled following earlier postponement due to the coronavirus pandemic.

South Eastern Road will be closed in sections working northwards from the junction with Grange Road, as defined below, to the extent indicated at any time by signs and barriers on site

PHASE 1 – closed between junctions with Grange Road and Crescent Road

Closure from 7 September for approximately 2-3 weeks

Alternative routes

Grange Road, Picton Road, Crescent Road ~ or ~

Vale Road, Cumberland Road, Duncan Road, Crescent Road

PHASE 2 – closed between junctions with Crescent Road and Ellington Road

Closure from 28 September for approximately 3-4 weeks

Alternative routes

Ellington Road, Picton Road and Crescent Road ~ or ~

Ellington Road, Duncan Road and Crescent Road

PHASE 3 – closed between junctions with Ellington Road and High Street

Closure from 26 October for approximately 4-5 weeks

Alternative routes

High Street, Park Road, Grange Road and Ellington Road ~ or ~

High Street, Cannon Road and Ellington Road

**PHASE 4 – closed between junctions with High Street and Park Road
Closure from 6 December 20 for approximately 2-3 weeks**

Alternative routes

Park Road and High Street ~ or ~

Park Road, Belmont Road and High Street

The timing of the above phases is approximate and may potentially be affected by weather and ground conditions. Any changes to dates will be notified to local residents and businesses and signposted on site.

Local access to the remainder of South Eastern Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed at any time.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

Waiting and loading will be prohibited at all times on South Eastern Road as and when and to the extent clearly indicated by No Waiting signs and cones placed on site.

This Order over-rides any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the sections of South Eastern Road defined in the preceding paragraph when the appropriate signage is displayed.

There is a chance that the planned dates may change, and updated information can be found on one.network – [SGN Gas Permit XW056W117327013-01194], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
