**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow gas service alteration works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Southwood Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 5th September 2022, with estimated completion by 9th September 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW071W118751533-01197\_01-01 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Southwood Road will be closed between the junctions of Grosvenor Road and Herbert Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas service alteration works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Southwood Road, Ashburnham Road, A255 High Street, A255 Nethercourt Hill, A255 Nethercourt Circus, B2054 London Road, Norman Road, Queen Bertha Road and vice versa.
