Spencer Square, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Spencer Square, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 18th October 2022, with estimated completion by 24th October 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT12148101-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Spencer Square will be closed outside number 41, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for traffic travelling clockwise is via Spencer Square, B2054 Paragon, B2054 St Augustines Road, Priory Road and Royal Road.

The alternative route for traffic travelling anti-clockwise is via Royal Road, B2054 Paragon and Spencer Square.
