(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow drainage connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Spratling Lane, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 30th January 2023, with estimated completion by 24th February 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE05028662556-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Spratling Lane will be closed between Spratling Street and Haine Lodge. Spratling Street will be closed at the junction with Spratling Lane.

Spratling Street will be reopened to through traffic when safe to do so, indicated by signage on site. Spratling Lane will remain closed for the whole duration until works are complete.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Spratling Street, Haine Road, New Haine Road, Manston Road, Preston Road and vice versa.
