



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**ST LUKE'S AVENUE, RAMSGATE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new foul sewer connection for the new Aldi Store, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St Luke's Avenue, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 1 November 2021 for up to 5 days.

St Luke's Avenue will be closed between the junctions with Hardres Road and Denmark Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Hardres Road, A255 Boundary Road and Denmark Road.

Local access to the remainder of St Luke's Avenue continues from a western direction up to the closure.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
