(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow sewer works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St Lukes Avenue & Anns Road, Ramsgate.

The closures are planned from 21st August 2023, with estimated completion by 22nd August 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT12714256-02 - Southern Water) (LQ003SWAT12714274-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

St Lukes Avenue will be closed at the junction with Denmark Road, between the hours of 08:30 and 18:00 only. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dane Road, St Lukes Road and vice versa.

Anns Road will be closed at the junction with Denmark Road, between the hours of 08:30 and 18:00 only. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Finsbury Road, A255 Boundary Road, Denmark Road and vice versa.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing sewer works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.
