**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stirling Way, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 18th August 2022, with estimated completion by 19th August 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70243224257-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Stirling Way will be closed between the junctions of Kingston Close and B2014 Newington Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2014 Newington Road, Bush Avenue, St Johns Avenue, St Johns Crescent, St Johns Avenue, Stirling Way and vice versa.
