**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**  
T1151C

To allow works to be carried out to install drainage connections for a new development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Sussex Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from day 2 March 2020, with estimated completion by 13 March 2020.

Sussex Street will be closed to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative routes for any through traffic are  
*Eastbound* via Hardres Street, A255 Boundary Road and King Street  
*Westbound* via King Street, Brunswick Street and Hardres Street

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
