



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
SUSSEX STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Sussex Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 6 July 2020 with estimated completion by 8 July 2020.

Sussex Street will be closed between the junction with Pike Lane and the Entrance to Loughborough Court.

Access to and from Pike Lane is via Hardres Street
Access to and from Loughborough Court is via King Street

The alternative routes for any through traffic are
Eastbound via Hardres Street, A255 Boundary Road and King Street
Westbound via King Street, Brunswick Street and Hardres Street

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
