SUSSEX STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

For the safety of the public and workforce during construction works for a new development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit parking on part of Sussex Street, Ramsgate.

Waiting and loading will be prohibited on the southern side of Sussex Street for the entire length on which no existing restrictions apply.

Waiting and loading will be prohibited all times between the following hours

- **Mondays to Fridays from 08:30 hours to 17:00 hours each day**
- **Saturdays from 09:00 hours to 13:00 hours each day**

These restrictions will be clearly indicated by single yellow lines and No Waiting signage displayed on site.

This Order suspends and overrides any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to Sussex Street.

This Order comes into force from 22 April 2019 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with completion currently estimated by 28 February 2021.
