Thanet Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow supply disconnection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Thanet Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 20th June 2022, with estimated completion by 24th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT11856424-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Thanet Road will be closed in the vicinity of number 17, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while supply disconnection works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Thanet Road, A255 Hereson Road, Montefiore Avenue, Dumpton Park Drive and vice versa.
