TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Thirlmere, Avenue will be closed to through traffic, on or after 18th October 2021 for up to 5 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Windermere Avenue and Rydal Avenue.

The alternative route is via Rydal Avenue, Coniston Avenue, Windermere Avenue and vice versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed for the duration of the works.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway maintenance to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
