(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Townley Street and Rodney Street, Ramsgate.

Closures are planned from Monday 3 August 2020 with estimated completion by 7 August 2020.

Townley Street will be closed in the general vicinity of number 2
The alternative routes for through traffic are
Eastbound via Royal Road, B2054 Paragon and Addington Street
Westbound via Addington Street, West Cliff Road and Royal Road

Rodney Street will be closed near the junction with Addington Street
Access to the remainder of Rodney Street continues via West Cliff Road

Only one road will be closed at any one time

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.
