(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow for new utility connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Upper Dumpton Park Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 24th January 2022, with estimated completion by 28th January 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW071W118275638-01396-02 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Upper Dumpton Park Road will be closed between numbers 17 and 19.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new utility connection works are undertaken by SGN. There may be collaborative working for other utility connections during this closure.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Upper Dumpton Park Road, Anns Road, Finsbury Road, A255 Boundary Road and vice versa.
