(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Canterbury Road West, Cliff View Road, King Arthur Road, and Foads Hill, Ramsgate.

The closures are planned between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours from 1st August 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd August 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WD1L076JMH1-04, BC008WD1L076JMH2-05, BC008WD1L076JMH3-04, BC008WD1L076JMH4-04 & BC008WD1L076JMH5-04 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The road closures are detailed below:

Canterbury Road West will be closed between the junctions of A299 Hengist Way and Arundel Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Cliff View Road will be closed at its junction with Canterbury Road West, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

King Arthur Road will be closed at its junction with Canterbury Road West, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Foads Hill will be closed at its junction with Canterbury Road West, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure are required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A299 Hengist Way, Canterbury Road West and vice versa.
