VARIOUS ROADS, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2020

To allow sewer works to be carried out as part of a programme to upgrade the sewer system in Thanet, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on certain roads in Ramsgate.

The roads affected, planned dates of closure and alternative routes are listed chronologically below.

VALE ROAD, RAMSGATE - closed in the vicinity of number 47
Closure planned from 16 March to 27 March 2020 inclusive
The alternative route is via Grange Road and Willson's Road

KING STREET, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 119
Closure planned from 24 March for up to 3 days
The alternative route is via B2054 Victoria Road, Victoria Parade, Wellington Crescent and Plains of Waterloo, and vice versa

ST LUKE'S AVENUE, RAMSGATE – closed between the junctions with St Luke's Road and Dane Road
Closure planned from 30 March for up to 3 days
The alternative route is via Dumpton Park Road, Dane Crescent, Dane Park Road and Salisbury Avenue –
Access to Dane Road will be maintained

All closures will be clearly indicated by signs and barriers on site, and local access to the remainder of each road will be maintained wherever possible.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.
