**VARIOUS ROADS, RAMSGATE &  
BROADSTAIRS - SEWER UPGRADE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow sewer works to be carried out as part of a programme to upgrade the sewer system in Thanet, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Ramsgate and Broadstairs.

The roads affected, planned dates of closure and alternative routes are listed chronologically below, first Ramsgate then Broadstairs

**RAMSGATE**

**LILLIAN ROAD, RAMSGATE** – closed in the vicinity of number 25  
Closure planned from 17 February for up to 3 days  
There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac*

**TOWNLEY STREET, RAMSGATE** – closed in the vicinity of number 39  
Closure planned from 18 February for up to 3 days  
The alternative routes are via Royal Road, B2054 Paragon, Royal Parade, Addington Street or via Addington Street, The Broadway, West Cliff Road and Royal Road

**ELLEN AVENUE, RAMSGATE** – closed in the vicinity of numbers 7 then number 20  
Closures planned from 19 February for up to 3 days  
There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac*

**RICHMOND ROAD, RAMSGATE** – closed in the vicinity of number 1 then number 2  
Closure planned from 20 February for up to 4 days  
The alternative route is via Crescent Road, Vale Square and Marlborough Road

**CHURCH ROAD, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of the junction with A255 Boundary Road**

**Closure planned from 2 March with completion by 13 March**

**The alternative routes are**

***Southbound* via A255 Boundary Road, Chatham Place, Chatham Street, High Street, Church Hill and Broad Street**

***Northbound* via Broad Street, Hardres Street and A255 Boundary Road.**

**CHAPEL PLACE, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of 2 The Old Pottery Cottages**

**Closure planned from 3 March for up to 3 days**

**The alternative route is via High Street, Cannon Road and Elms Avenue**

**The One-way Traffic Order will be suspended to allow essential access**

**BALMORAL PLACE, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 3**

**Closure planned from 5 March for up to 3 days**

**There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac***

**Closure in conjunction with traffic control outside Winifred Villas**

**MILL COTTAGES, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 11 then at the junction with Grange Road**

**Closure planned from 6 March with completion by 10 March**

**There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac***

**MONTEFIORE COTTAGES, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 11 then at the side of 61 Hereson road**

**Closure planned from 7 March with completion by 11 March**

**There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac***

**PRIORY ROAD, RAMSGATE – closures in the vicinity of number 3 then 15**

**Closures planned from 18 March for up to 3 days**

**The alternative routes are**

***Southbound* via Royal Road and B2054 St Augustine's Road**

***Northbound* via B2054 St Augustine's Road, Grange Road, West Cliff Road and Royal Road.**

**WINSTANLEY CRESCENT, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of numbers 13 and 42**

**Closure planned from 18 March for up to 3 days**

**There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac***

**HILLBROW ROAD, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 6 and number 2**

**Closure planned from 23 March for up to 3 days**

**The alternative route is via Bolton Street, Central Road and King's Road**

**SPENCER STREET, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 1**

**Closure planned from 23 March for up to 3 days**

**There is no alternative route. The One-way Traffic Order will be suspended to allow essential access**

**ARKLOW SQUARE, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of the junction with B2054 Victoria Road**  
**Closure planned from 25 March for up to 3 days**  
**The alternative route is via with B2054 Victoria Road, Bellevue Road and Artillery Road**

#### **BROADSTAIRS**

**SOWELL STREET, BROADSTAIRS – closed in the vicinity of number 12 and 23**  
**Closure planned from 16 March for up to 3 days**  
**The alternative route is via St Peters Road, Crawford Road and St Peters Park Road**

**QUEENS GARDENS, BROADSTAIRS – closed in the vicinity of number 3**  
**Closure planned from 19 March with completion by 23 March**  
**The alternative route is via Victoria Parade**

**All closures will be clearly indicated by signs and barriers on site, and local access to the remainder of each road will be maintained wherever possible.**

**Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents when it is safe to do so, especially for roads that are *cul-de-sacs*, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons**

**Due to the nature of the works, all restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.**

**These works are part of an extensive programme which is subject to weather and other factors that may potentially cause changes at short notice; every effort will be made to keep as close as possible to the planned dates shown above, and any changes will be notified locally and signposted on site.**
