**VARIOUS ROADS, RAMSGATE &
BROADSTAIRS - SEWER UPGRADE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2019

To allow works to be carried out as part of an ongoing programme to replace Thanet's ageing sewers, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Ramsgate and Broadstairs.

The roads affected, planned dates of closure and alternative routes are as shown below, listed alphabetically.

Due to the nature of the works, all restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.

BROADSTAIRS

ALEXANDRA ROAD – initially closed outside number 5 and then moving to closure outside number 21
Closure from 2 September to 30 September 2019 inclusive
There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac*

BELVEDERE ROAD – initially closed outside number 13 for approximately 30 days, then at the junction with Dundonald Road for 10 days
Closure from 1 August to 16 September 2019 inclusive
Alternative routes
Southbound via High Street, Charlotte Street, York Street and York Avenue
Northbound via York Avenue, Queen's Road and High Street

SOWELL STREET – closed in the vicinity of number 27
Closure from 1 August to 31 August 2019 inclusive
Alternative route via B2053 St Peter's Park Road, Crawford Road and St Peter's Road

RAMSGATE

BLOOMSBURY ROAD – closed in the vicinity of number 13
Closure from 31 August to 3 September 2019 inclusive
Alternative route via Lorne Road, Southwood Road and Napleton Road

**BOLTON STREET – closed alongside 18 Hillbrow Road
Closure from 8 September to 13 September 2019 inclusive
Alternative route via Central Road, Princes Road and Hillbrow Road**

**CENTRAL ROAD – closed outside numbers 28 and 14
Closure from 8 September to 13 September 2019 inclusive
Alternative route via Kings Road, Hillbrow Road and Princes Road**

**CHARLES ROAD – closed outside number 13
Closure from 3 August to 6 August inclusive
Alternative route via Leopold Road, Holly Road**

**ELMS AVENUE – closed outside number 3
Closure from 11 August to 14 August inclusive
Alternative route via Carlton Avenue, Marlborough Road, Vale Square and West Cliff Road**

**LORNE ROAD – closed outside number 12
Closure from 31 August to 3 September inclusive
Alternative route via Southwood Road, Grange Road and Mays Road**

**MILL COTTAGES – closed outside number 11 for approximately 14 days then closed at the junction with Grange Road
Closure from 12 August to 8 September inclusive
There is no alternative route as the road is a *cul-de-sac***

**NAPLETON ROAD – closed at the junction with Edith Road
Closure from 5 August to 9 August inclusive
Alternative route via St Mildred's Road, Queen Bertha Road and Edith Road**

**PICTON ROAD – closed in phases from number 63 to the junction with Crescent Road
Closure from 1 August to 31 August inclusive
Alternative route via Grange Road, Vale Road and Crescent Road**

**TRURO ROAD – closed at the junction with Augusta Road
Closure from 13 August to 16 August inclusive
Alternative route via B2054 Victoria Road, Victoria Parade and Augusta Road**

All closures are clearly indicated by signs and barriers on site, and local access to the remainder of each road is being maintained wherever possible.

These works are part of an extensive programme which is subject to weather and other factors that may potentially cause changes at short notice; every effort will be made to keep as close as possible to the planned dates shown above, and any changes will be notified locally and signposted on site.
