**VARIOUS ROADS, RAMSGATE –
THANET SEWER UPGRADE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2019

To allow works to be carried out as part of an ongoing programme to replace Thanet's ageing sewers, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Ramsgate

The roads affected, current estimated dates of closure and alternative routes are as shown below.

The planned start dates and duration of closures are approximate and may potentially be affected by weather and ground conditions.

BLOOMSBURY ROAD – closed from the vicinity of number 13 to junction with Lorne Road

Closure planned from 1 July to 9 August 2019

The alternative route is via Lorne Road, Mays Road, Grange Road Southwood Road and Napleton Road

CHURCH ROAD – closed in vicinity of number 68A

Closure planned from 1 July to 31 July 2019

The alternative routes are

***Southbound* via A255 Boundary Road, King Street, Broad Street**

***Northbound* via Broad Street, Hardres Street and A255 Boundary Road**

WINSTANLEY CRESCENT – closed in vicinity of 65, then 105

Closures planned from 1 July to 31 August 2019

The alternative route is via A254 Margate Road and the remainder of Winstanley Crescent

ADDINGTON STREET – closed at the junction with Townley Street

Closure planned from 4 July to 7 July 2019

The alternative route is via West Cliff Road, Queen Street, Leopold Street and Royal Parade

The one-way traffic Order in respect of Addington Street will be suspended when the appropriate signage is covered or replaced.

TOWNLEY STREET – closed from number 39 to the junction with Addington Street

Closure planned from 4 July to 7 July 2019

The alternative route is via Royal Road, Paragon, Addington Street

Access will be maintained for residents when safe to do so

This road will be re-opened outside the working hours

All closures will be clearly indicated by signs and barriers on site, and local access to the remainder of each road will be maintained wherever possible

Due to the nature of the works, all restrictions will need to remain in force outside the working hours, except where otherwise stated.

These works are part of an extensive programme which is subject to weather and other factors that may potentially cause changes at short notice; every effort will be made to keep as close as possible to the planned dates shown above, and any changes will be notified locally and signposted on site.
