**VARIOUS ROADS, RAMSGATE –
THANET SEWER UPGRADE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow works to be carried out as part of a programme to replace Thanet's ageing sewers, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Ramsgate

The roads affected, current estimated dates of closure and alternative routes are as shown below.

The planned start dates and duration of closures are approximate and may potentially be affected by weather and ground conditions.

COLLEGE ROAD, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 42
Closure in conjunction with 2-way temporary traffic lights
Closure planned from 11 February for up to 2 weeks
The alternative route is via Holly Road, St Luke's Avenue, Margate Road and College Road

BOLTON STREET, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 3
Closure planned from 11 February for up to 2 weeks
The alternative route is via Hillbrow Road, Princes Road, Central Road and Kings Road

ST MILDRED'S ROAD, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of the junction with Napleton Road
Closure planned from 15 February for up to 2 weeks
The alternative route is via Queen Bertha Road, Edith Road and Grange Road

HILLBROW ROAD, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of the junction with Bolton Street
Closure planned from 8 March for up to 2 weeks
The alternative route is via Princes Road, Central Road and Kings Road

TRURO ROAD, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of the junction with Albion Road

Closure planned from 8 March for up to 2 weeks

The alternative route is via Belle Vue Road, Victoria Road, Victoria Parade and Albert Road

ADDINGTON STREET, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of the junction with Albert Street

Closure planned from 15 April for up to 2 weeks

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Addington Street will be suspended up to where the road is closed, to allow essential access / exit

The alternative route is via Nelson Crescent, Prospect Terrace, Sion Hill, Rose Hill, Cliff Street, Queen Street, West Cliff Road

The alternative route for Albert Street is via Hertford Street and West Cliff Road

ELMS AVENUE, RAMSGATE – closed in the vicinity of number 28

Closure planned from 1 May for up to 2 weeks

The alternative route is via Carlton Avenue, Marlborough Road, Vale Square, West Cliff Road, Queen Street and Elms Avenue

ST LAWRENCE AVENUE, RAMSGATE – closed at the junction with Minster Road

Closure in conjunction with 3-way temporary traffic lights

Closure planned from 1 May for up to 2 weeks

The alternative route is via Minster Road, Goodwin Road and London Road

All closures are to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site, and local access to the remainder of each road will be maintained wherever possible

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force outside the working hours.

These works are part of an extensive programme which is subject to weather and other factors that may potentially cause changes at short notice; every effort will be made to keep as close as possible to the planned dates shown above, and any changes will be notified locally and signposted on site.
