West Cliff Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of West Cliff Road, Ramsgate in 2 phases, as detailed below:

Phase 1 - part of West Cliff Road, Ramsgate, will be closed from 6th June 2022, with estimated completion by 9th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT11710251-04 - Southern Water).

Phase 2 - part of West Cliff Road, Ramsgate, will be closed from 10th June 2022, with estimated completion by 10th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT11710251-04 - Southern Water).

The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The road closure lengths for each phase are detailed below:

Phase 1 - West Cliff Road will be closed at its junctions with Cannonbury Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Phase 2 - West Cliff Road will be closed at its junction with B2054 Grange Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic for both phases is via B2054 Grange Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Paragon, B2054 Royal Parade, Leopold Street, Queen Street, West Cliff Road, and vice versa.
