WEST CLIFF ROAD, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of West Cliff Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Monday 1 July 2019 for an estimated period of up to 2 weeks.

West Cliff Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Grange Road / London Road.

Local access to the remainder of West Cliff Road / Queen Street, continues from a Ramsgate direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The alternative route for through traffic is via B2054 Grange Road, St Augustine's Road, Paragon, Royal Parade and Leopold Street.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
