THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

Kent County Council works.

To allow resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2054 London Road, West Cliff Road & Queen Street, Ramsgate.

A rolling closure is planned from 15th November 2023, with estimated completion by 21st November 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70566971810-02 - Kent County Council) (GE70591742417-02 - Kent County Council) (GE70552327662-02 -Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The closures will be a rolling closure. Once works are completed on one road, works for the next will begin.

B2054 London Road will be closed between the junctions of Stancomb Avenue and B2054 Grange Road, between the hours of 19:00 and 05:00 only. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any Westbound through traffic is via B2054 Grange Road, Watchester Avenue and Stancomb Avenue.

The alternative route for any Eastbound through traffic is via Stancomb Avenue, Royal Esplanade and B2054 Grange Road.

West Cliff Road will be closed between the junctions of B2054 Grange Road and Royal Road, between the hours of 19:00 and 05:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Queen Street, Leopold Street, B2054 Royal Parade, B2054 Paragon, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Grange Road and vice versa.

Queen Street will be closed between the junctions of Hertford Street and Leopold Street, between the hours of 19:00 and 05:00 only.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Leopold Street, B2054 Royal Parade, B2054 Paragon, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Grange Road, West Cliff Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and

workforce while allowing resurfacing works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Kent County Council.
