West Cliff Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow pipe replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of West Cliff Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 27th March 2023, with estimated completion by 29th March 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT12409914-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

West Cliff Road will be closed between the junctions of B2054 Grange Road and Queen Street. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing pipe replacement works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via West Cliff Road, Queen Street, Leopold Street, B2054 Royal Parade, B2054 Westcliff Arcade, B2054 Paragon, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Grange Road and vice versa.
