WINSTANLEY CRESCENT, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Winstanley Crescent, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 23 November 2020, with estimated completion by 25 November 2020.

Winstanley Crescent will be closed in the general vicinity of its eastern junction with A254 Margate Road, to the actual extent indicated on site.

Local access to the remainder of Winstanley Crescent continues from its western junction with A254 Margate Road

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
